	<p>Cllr Collins introduced himself as the County Councillor for the area and Deputy Leader of KCC. He apologised for not visiting the parish sooner. He is available and is keen to be contacted on brian.collins@kent.gov.uk.</p> <p>He feels the potholes should be reported and then will be fixed. Anything not repaired must be brought to the attention of Cllr Collins. The main contractor is to be changed, this should make a difference. If the potholes aren't repaired within 28 days, they should be reported to Cllr Collins and he will take this forward. He also hopes a new structure will allow the Highways Inspector to undertake the completion of potholes and those nearby.</p> <p>Cllr Collins came via Brabourne this evening and noticed the poor state of the roads in the parish.</p> <p>Cllr Dryland asked if the new contractor went out to tender, it did. Cllr Dryland highlighted how bad Wye Hill is.</p> <p>Adult Social Care is out of control and Central Government is not covering this expense. There is a fair funding review has not been published by Government yet. KCC waiting on reports before setting their own budgets for 2026-27. KCC has rescinded the Climate Emergency as it hampered what the Council wanted to do as it stopped local contractors being able to tender as the smaller company didn't have a Net Zero policy.</p> <p>KCC has a policy of no solar farms on agricultural land. Stone Street Solar was allowed and the fact that it was an NSIP would mean KCC could not be involved. The BESS storage at Aldington was a concern. Brabourne BESS has been refused by ABC and whether it goes to Planning Appeal is unknown yet.</p> <p>KCC is not against Solar energy but feel it should be in the correct place.</p> <p>70-acre lorry park in Capel, does that have KCC involvement? Space needs to be provided somewhere.</p> <p>Cllr Betty had circulated his report.</p>

	It is hoped that the International Station will re-open.
